01


Wander through the gallery and find an artwork that you find interesting. Spend a few minutes with the artwork, looking at the shapes, textures and images. Think about the images (and other elements) in the artwork. Pay close attention to how the artwork makes you feel.

02

Imagine you are a person who has first-hand experience of the events (or themes) related to the artwork. Depending on the artwork, you might imagine that you are a soldier, a villager, a journalist, a refugee, a young child, a Vietnam veteran or someone else.

03

Write a letter home to a friend or relative describing your situation, what you are thinking and how you are feeling.



Write the date, then a greeting (such as Dear... or Hi...) to introduce your letter.

Write a sentence (or two) to describe your situation, including information about:

- The country of Viet Nam
- the Vietnam War

Write a few sentences about your experiences including:

- things you saw
- people you met
- places you visited

Write a sentence about your feelings and emotions. For example, excitement, anger, hurt, confusion, distress, relief etc

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End your letter (eg Bye... From... Love...) then add your name.c
